## INTRODUCTION

Your D-522 is an external hard drive with a multimedia function making possible to look at your pictures and videos on your TV in high definition, or to listen your music.

## OPERATING

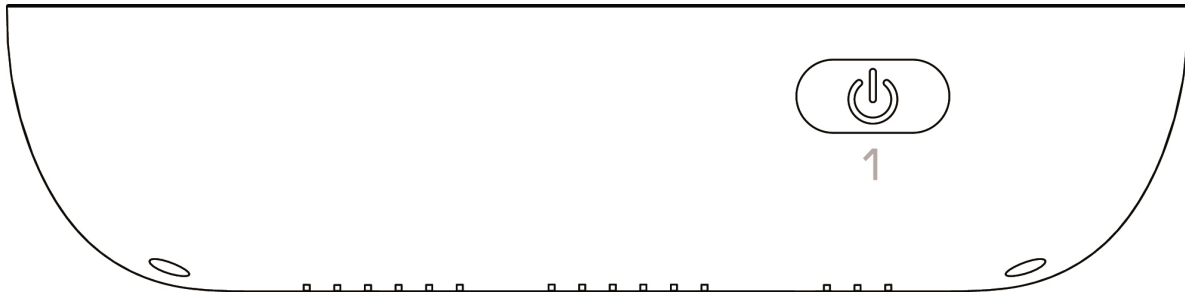
- Connected in USB to the computer, you can copy the files on your hard disk to the hard disk of D-522.
- When disconnected from the computer, connect the D-522 to your TV to visualize your multimedia files in high definition.

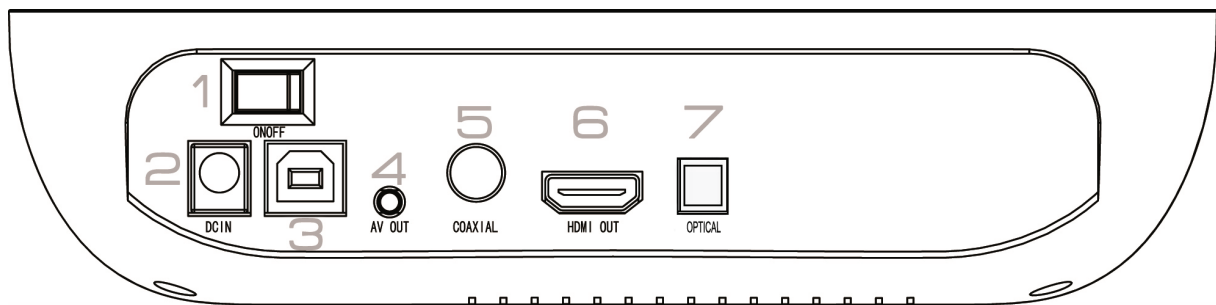
## UNIT DETAIL

### FRONT PANEL



1. **IR** : To receive the signal of the remote control.  
**ON LED** : to see the state of the power (blue LED).  
**HDD LED** : to see the state of playing files (green LED).  
**STANDBY LED** : To see the state of the power (red LED).

### REAR PANEL



1. **POWER** : Switch ON/OFF.
2. **DC IN** : To connect the power supply adapter.
3. **USB 2.0** : To connect the D-522 to the PC.
4. **VIDEO OUT** : AV output.
5. **COAXIAL** : Sound output coaxial.
6. **HDMI** : AV output (HDMI).
7. **OPTICAL** : Sound output optical.


























### SIDE PANEL



1. **USB HOST** : To connect an USB device (USB stick or external hard disk).

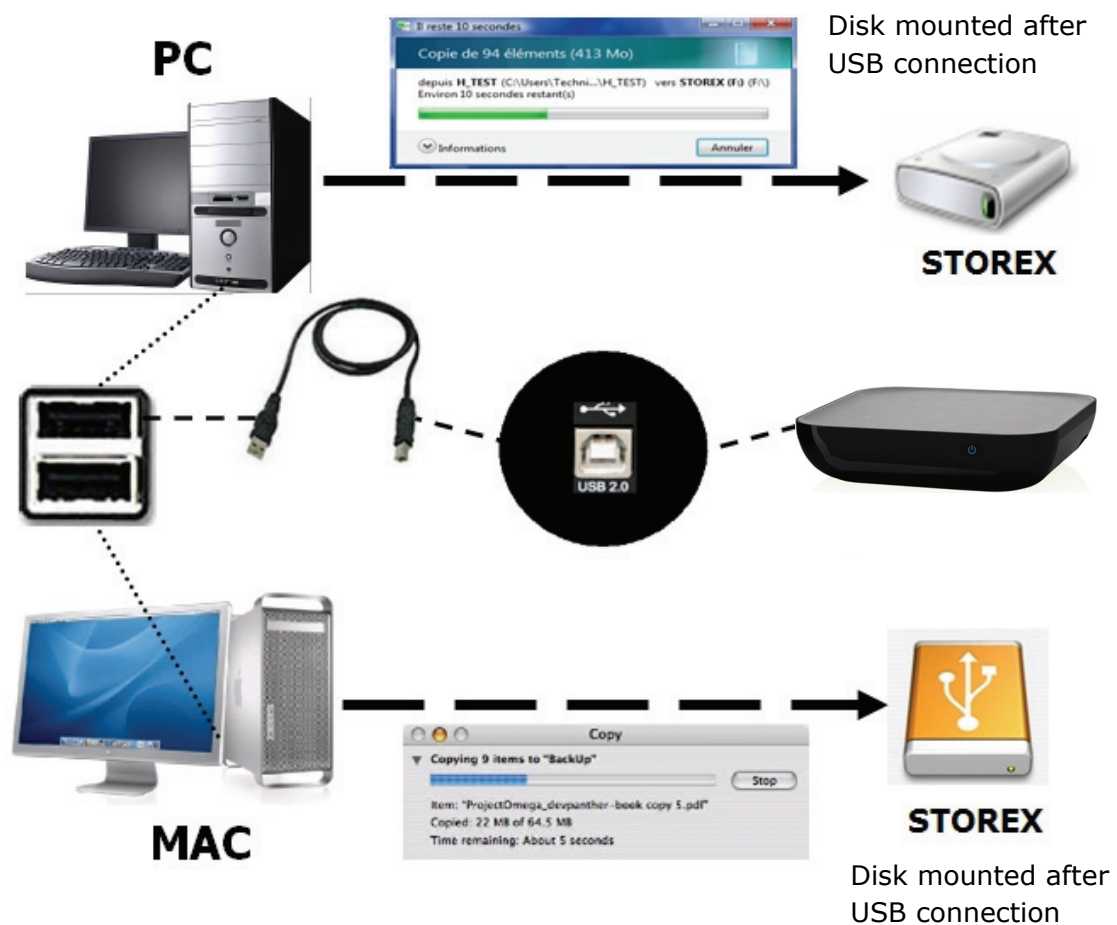

1	<b>STANDBY</b>		Power on/Power off (Standby) D-522.
2	<b>MUTE</b>		Activate /Deactivate the sound.
3	<b>TASKBAR</b>		Allows the user to call the shortcut bar while viewing a file.
4	<b>MOVIE</b>		Allow to access directly to the "VIDEO" page.
5	<b>PHOTO</b>		Allow to access directly to the "PHOTO" page.
6	<b>MUSIC</b>		Allow to access directly to the "MUSIC" page.
7	<b>FILE</b>		Allow to access directly to the "FILE" page.
8	<b>FR</b>		Fast Rewind (2x, 4x, 8x...).
9	<b>FF</b>		Fast forward (2x, 4x, 8x...).
10	<b>DIRECTIONAL KEYS</b> <b>CONFIRM</b>		Allow to navigate throw the browser. Allow to validate your selection. The ◀ key, allow to jump to the previous page (PAG-) in the browser. The ▶ key, allow to jump to the next page (PAG+) in the browser.
11	<b>BACK</b>		Allow to exit/get back from the previous page.

## CONNECT THE D-522 TO THE COMPUTER

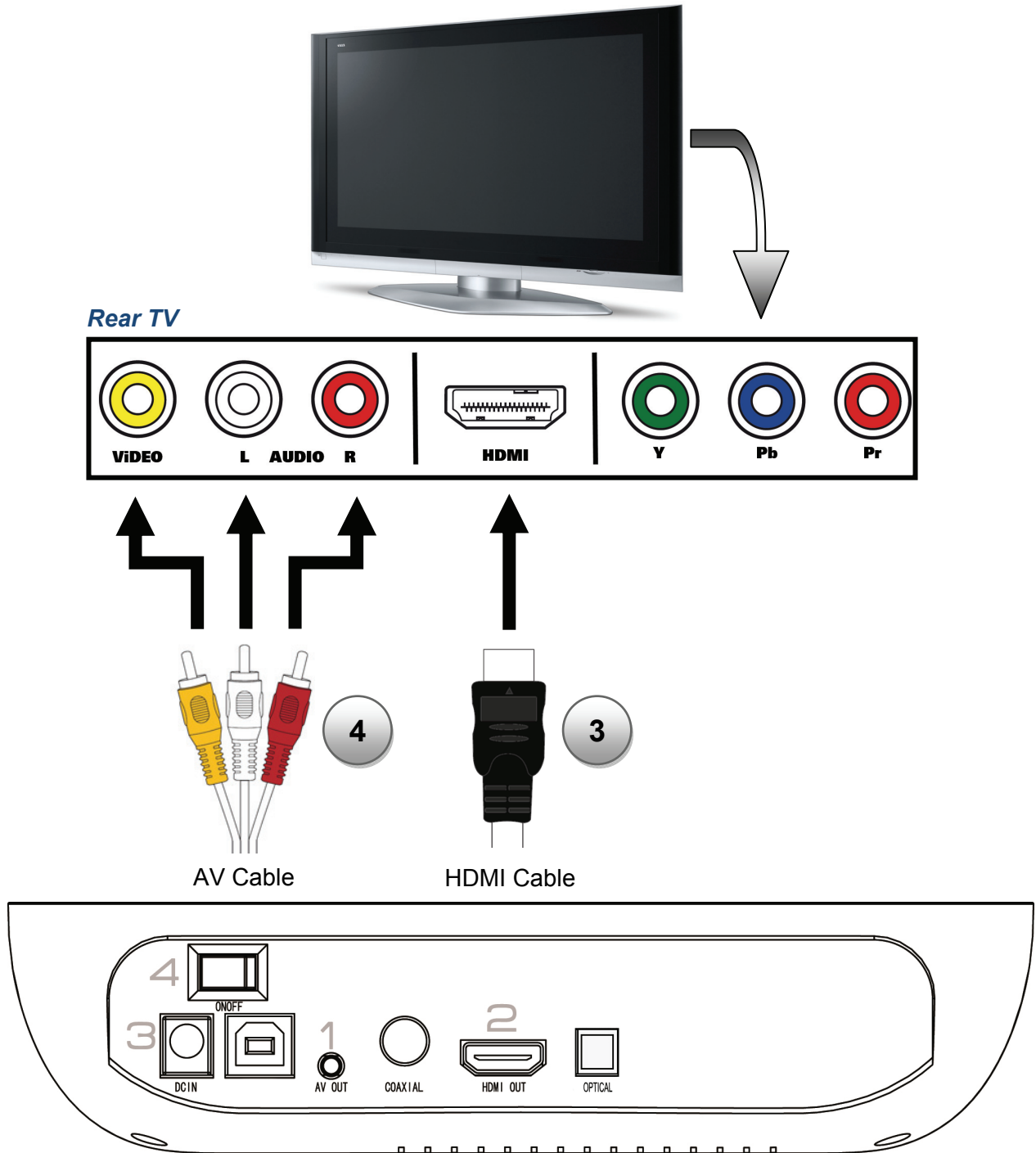
1. Connect the power supply adapter to the **DC IN** socket.
2. Put the switch behind the product to "ON".
3. Connect the USB cable with the PC or MAC.
4. The "Standby" LED lights on BLUE color.
5. Take a look on "**My computer**", the STOREX device will appear with an additional letter or for MAC users it will automatically mount on the desktop.
6. Just drag and drop or "**copy/paste**" all your files into the disk and enjoy watching.



**IMPORTANT HINT :** The MAC users cannot use the unit, for a file transfer, if it's formatted in NTFS file system, unless they install an additional driver like "NTFS-3G".



## CONNECT THE D-522 TO THE TV

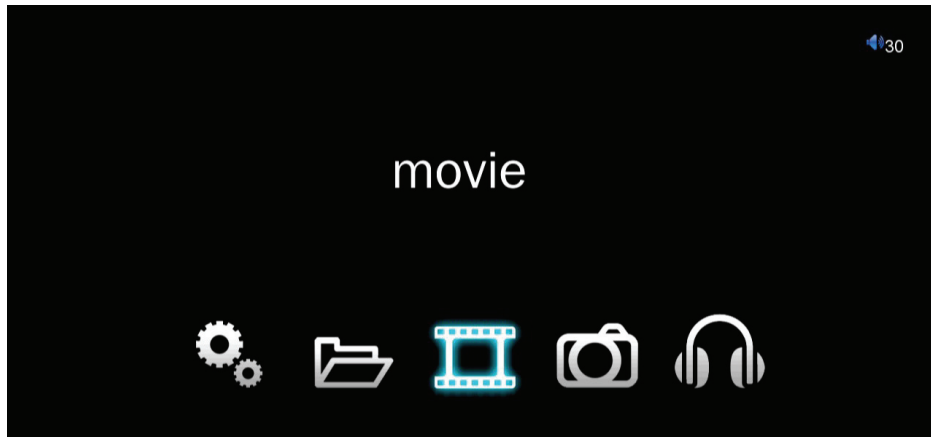


1. Connect the D-522 to the television with the AV cable (depending on your configuration).
2. Connect the D-522 to the television with the provided HDMI cable (depending on your configuration).
3. Connect the power supply adapter behind the D-522.
4. Put the switch behind the product to **ON**.
5. Make sure that your TV is on the good channel; basically a schema can guide you (AV1, AV2, EXT1, EXT2...).
6. The "Standby" LED lights on BLUE color.
7. The LCD display "**LOAD**" and the TV display "**Loading**".
8. The home menu will appear after few seconds.

## PLAYING FILES

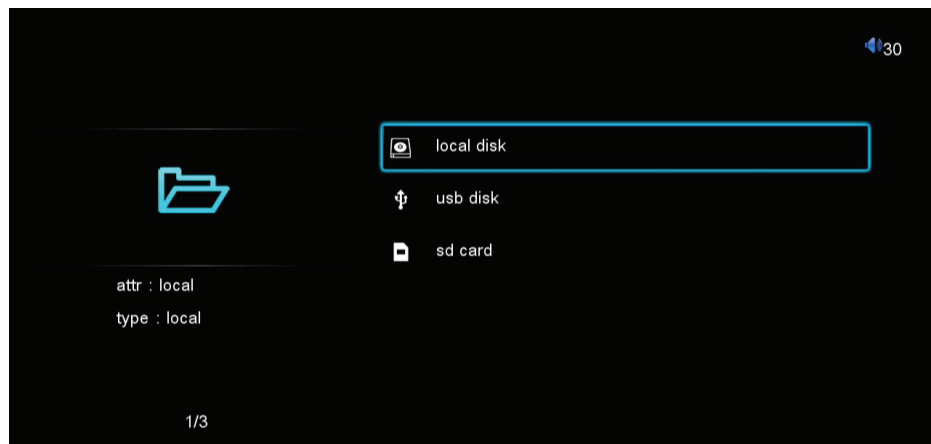
1. The first page (**HOME**) shows 4 mains icons, which 4 of them can be accessed from the remote control (VIDEO, MUSIC, PHOTO and FILE). Select one of the four modes using directional keys in the middle of the remote control and press "**ENTER**". To use the remote control please refer to previous remote control details.

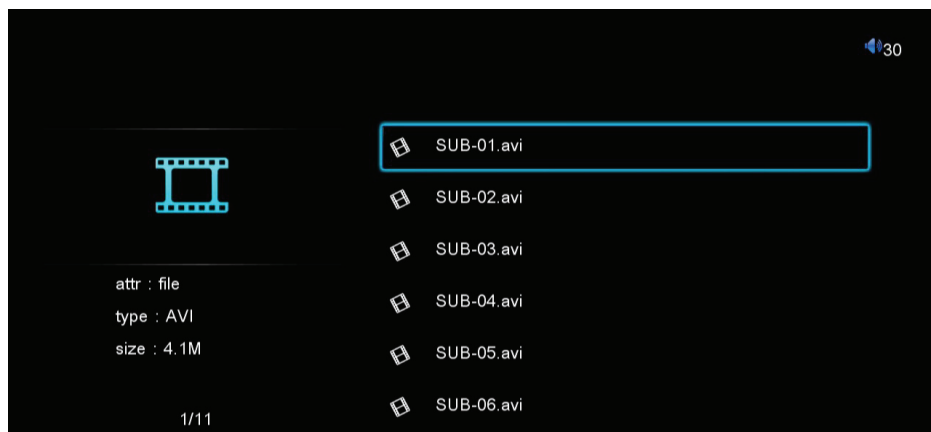


2. Select the device.

Use directional keys on remote control then press "**ENTER**".



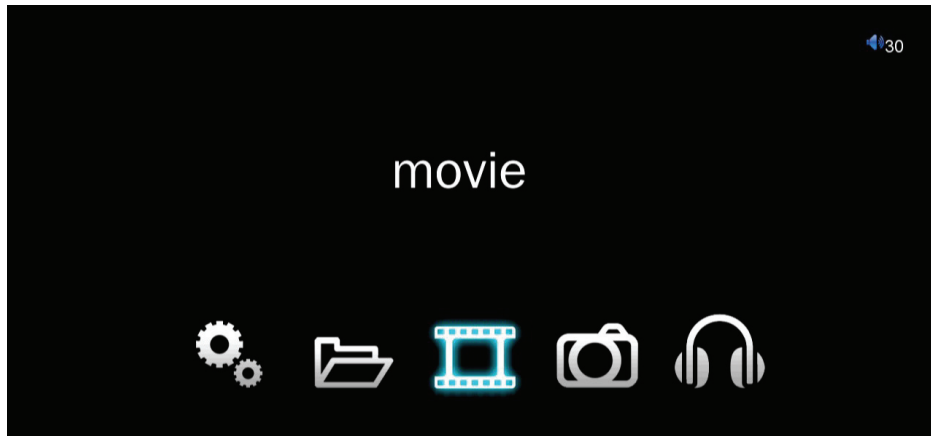
3. Press the directional keys to move highlights to select the desired files then press "**ENTER**" to confirm your Selection.



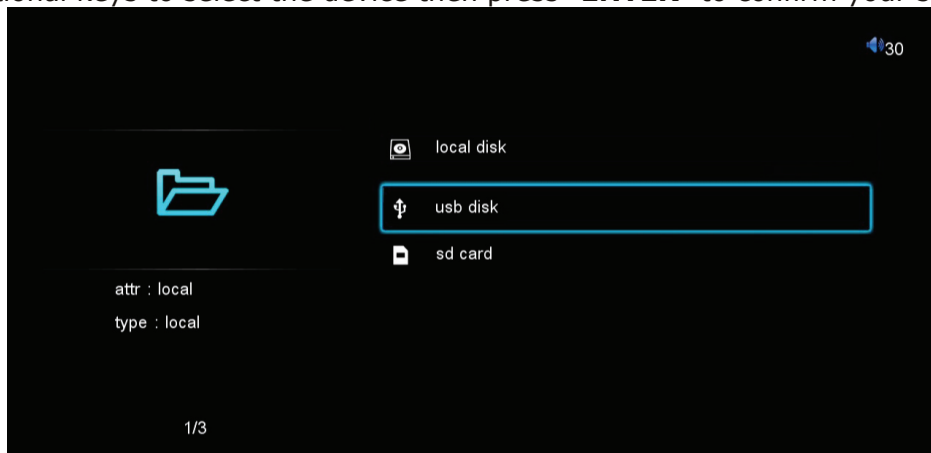
## HOW TO READ ON A DEVICE

2. Select one of the four modes using directional keys in the middle of the remote control and press "**ENTER**". To use the remote control please refer to previous remote control details.

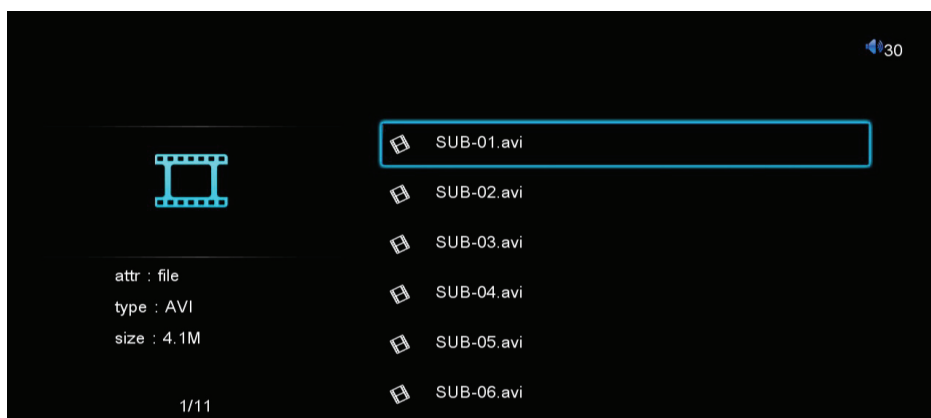

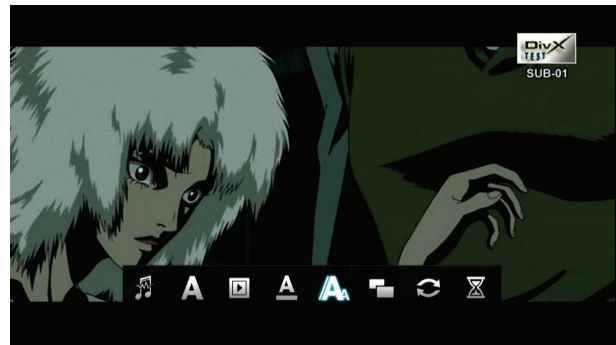
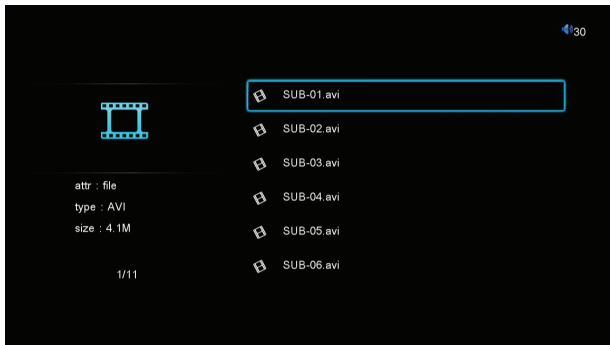
3. Select the device (External hard disk, USB key or memory card). Use directional keys to select the device then press "**ENTER**" to confirm your selection.



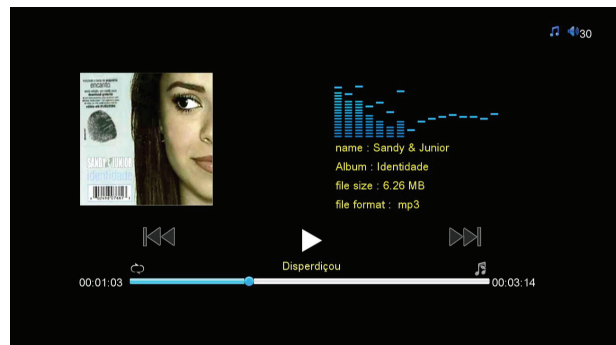
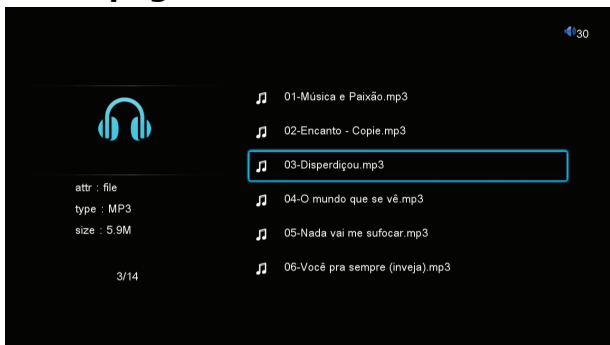

## QUICK EXPLANATION


**Video:** Watch all your favorite movies in this mode.

**Music:** Listen all your favorite music's in this mode.

## SHORTCUT BAR

When you press  on the remote control, while playing a file, there is a shortcut bar that appears on the screen to make easy access for some functions.

According to the mode you are using (Video, Music, or Pictures) the shortcut bar shows different icons.

### SHORTCUT BAR FOR MOVIE MODE :



- 1 : Change audio track.
- 2 : Select the subtitle track.
- 3 : Select the encoding method (subtitle).
- 4 : Modify the subtitle color.
- 5 : Modify the subtitle size.  
Activate/Deactivate the subtitle function.
- 6 : Select the display format (full screen, 4:3, 16:9...).
- 7 : Select repetition mode (Repeat one, Repeat all, Random...).
- 8 : Activate the "**GoTo**" function (search by time).

### SHORTCUT BAR FOR MUSIC MODE :



- 1 : Get back to previous page.
- 2 : Select repetition mode (Repeat one, Repeat all, Random...).
- 3 : Select the equalizer type.
- 4 : Activate/Deactivate lyrics.
- 5 : Select lyrics color.

**SHORTCUT BAR FOR PICTURE MODE :**



- 1 : Get back to previous page.
- 2 : Play/Pause slideshow.
- 3 : Select the rotation, move or zoom on the picture (image 1).
- 4 : Makes appear on the right side of the screen a picture selection list in "miniature" view (image 2).
- 5 : Select the transition effect between pictures.
- 6 : Modify the display time picture.
- 7 : Select repetition mode (Repeat one, Repeat all, Random...).

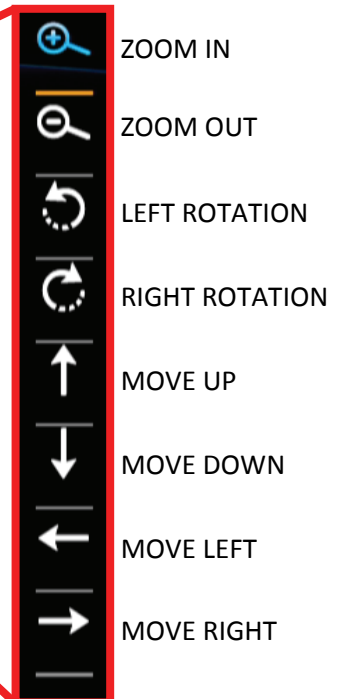

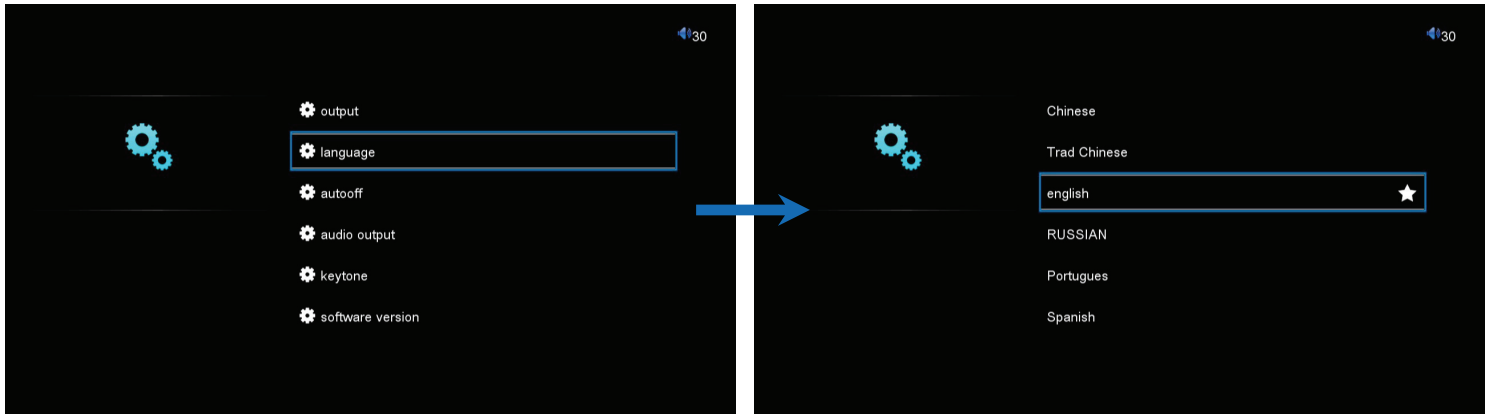


# SETTINGS

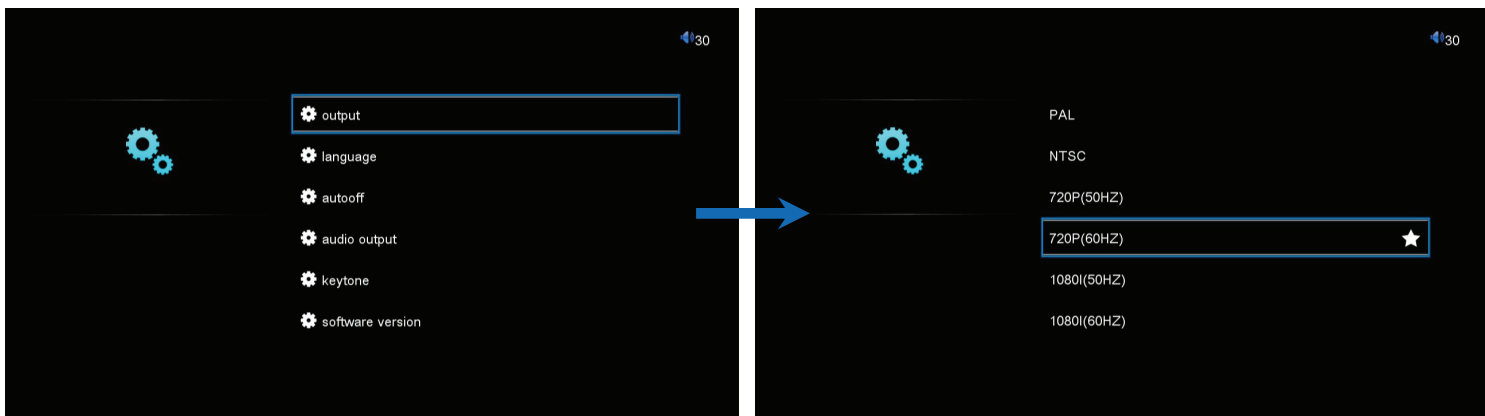
In this page you can set all the settings included the language.

## SECURITY INFORMATION

## GENERAL

- Do not shake the unit, it may damage the hard disk built inside your D-522.
- Use only the accessories (power supply...) provided by the manufacturer.
- Do not move the unit when it is in operation.

## **SECURITY**

- In order to avoid fires or electric shock, do not place the unit under objects filled with liquids.
- If a heavy object or liquid were to fall on the unit, unplug it immediately and have it checked by a qualified staff before the re-use.
- In operation, the surface of the enclosure generates heat; therefore, place the unit on a flat and rigid surface and avoid covering the unit with something.

## **ELECTRICAL POWER SUPPLY OF THE UNIT**

- In case of non-prolonged use of the unit or in case of thunderstorm, unplug the unit from the wall socket, without pulling the cable itself.
- The power adapter provided is specific to the product. The use of an adapter other could damage the product or cause accidents.

## **CHOICE OF THE LOCATION OF THE PRODUCT**

- Install the unit far from any equipment to strong attraction such as micro-waves, large loudspeakers...
- Place your unit in an adequate ventilated place and on a flat surface and rigid to disperse the heat emitted by the unit.

## **CLEANING**
