CONNECT UNIT TO YOUR TV

4. Check if your TV is on the right channel, normally there is diagram to guide you (AV1, AV2, HDMI1, HDMI2...).

5. A notification will appear automatically, select the resolution by pressing it.



To turn on / off unit, press the **POWER** button for 3 seconds. To turn off select " turn off the MID".

• ENABLE/DISABLE LCD

Once the unit is turned on, short press POWER to turn off the LCD screen, and you will save energy. To turn on the LCD screen, press POWER again.
